ECTC to Host Classes in Green County this Fall

Elizabethtown Community and Technical College will be offering a variety of classes this fall in Greensburg as part of the Workforce Solutions Community Education program. Classes being offered include: Basic & Advanced Photography, Quickbooks, eBay: Learn to sell your stuff, Genealogy, iPad: Basics & Beyond. All classes will be offered at the new Greensburg Community and Senior Center.

Basic Photography (\$115) will cover cameras, their operations and how to shoot amazing images with them. Both traditional and digital cameras will be covered along with specific shooting techniques to get the most out of your camera. This class will be offered on Tuesday evenings beginning September 10th through October 15th from 6 to 8pm local time.

Advanced Photography (\$115) is an intermediate photography class. This class will cover more camera operations, more advanced shooting techniques and participants will learn the difference between capturing images and taking snap shots. In addition to these camera operations,

participants will learn how to display, present and store images after they have been produced. This class will be offered on Tuesday evenings beginning October 22nd through November 26th from 6 to 8pm local time.

The **QuickBooks** (\$99) course will cover everything from invoicing and receiving payments to paying bills, managing payroll and more. This course will be offered September 9th through September 10th and October 21st through October 22nd from 6 to 8pm local time.

Genealogy (\$35) is a 3 hour class for those interested in finding out about their family history. The course will cover resources available for tracing your family tree. This Genealogy course is going to be offered on Monday, September 9th and Monday, October 21st from 6 to 9pm local time.

In the **iPad: Basics and Beyond** (\$39) class, you will learn basic skills for using your Apple iPad. Included will be downloading free apps, customizing the buttons, using Calendar, Notes, Maps, etc. along with transforming

your screen by flicking it, squeezing it, tapping it and dragging it and other basic functions. The only requirement is that you must bring your own iPad. The iPad: Basics and Beyond class will be offered on Monday, September 16th and Monday, November 18th from 5:30 to 8:30pm local time.

The course, **eBay: Learn to sell your stuff** (\$99), will cover the basics of eBay and how to sell your items online, whether it be for personal or a business. This class will be offered on August 5th and August 6th and October 7th and October 8th from 6 to 9pm local time.

The ECTC Workforce Solutions program exists to provide those with personal enrichment and job training for a lifetime of learning. ECTC offers a multitude of adult enrichment and job-skills training opportunities for students of all ages.

Storm Warnings & Alerts for Greensburg Citizens

The City of Greensburg uses CodeRED to deliver severe storm warnings and alerts to the citizens of Greensburg. There have been some questions of how to get on the list so that you may receive alerts when severe weather is in our area. In order to ensure that you receive notifications, please make sure your information has been added to the database! Required information includes first and last name, street address (physical address, no P.O. boxes), city, state, zip code, and primary phone number, additional phone numbers can be entered as well.

In an effort to make this service available to everyone there are a few options to make sure you're not left in the dark:

1. Go online to www.greensburgonline.com/CodeRed and fill out the form for the City of Greensburg. Make sure to sign up for an account so you can manage your contact preferences!

2. If you do not have a computer or access to the internet, fill out the form to the right and return it to Greensburg City Hall and we will make sure your information is added to the database. Each field below is required. Please make sure you fill out the information to the best of your ability.
