

City of Greensburg
Zoning Map Amendment Ordinance
Ordinance Number A2010-0125

WHEREAS, the provisions of the Kentucky Revised Statues (KRS 100.201 – 100.991) empower the City of Greensburg to divide the territory within the city’s jurisdiction into zones in order to:

- Promote public health, safety and general welfare;
- Facilitate orderly and harmonious development and the visual and historic character of the city;
- Regulate the density of population and intensity of the land use in order to provide for the adequate infrastructure, open space, light, and air;

WHEREAS, the City of Greensburg Planning & Commission has recommended to the Greensburg City Council that the following **map amendments** be adopted;

WHEREAS, the City of Greensburg has made a commitment to the citizen’s of this community to provide for adequate land use, and growth; and

WHEREAS, the State of Kentucky requires that each City Government update their Comprehensive Plan every three (3) to five (5) years;

WHEREAS, having had First and Second Reading of Zoning Map Amendment Ordinance, and advertised a Public Hearing for inspection; now

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Greensburg that Zoning Map Amendment Number **A2010-0125** be approved as amended.
